Sorry for the delay, I've been seeking some clarifications and guidance from a couple of colleagues who have been closer to this NSIP and also our legal team.

Having clarified I'm not up to speed on the process and in particular the role of the protective provisions, we are now satisfied that it is appropriate for the Land Drainage act to be disapplied, and the DCO and protective provisions be the controls process for this.
