

Application by Xlinks 1 Limited for Xlinks comprising the installation, operation and maintenance of two converter stations, highway improvement works, and HVDC and HVAC cables.

Case reference: EN010164

Examining Authority's note of unaccompanied site inspection (USI) to which the application or specified matters relates on 1 April 2025

Examining Inspectors Andrea Mageean, Frances Wilkinson and Liam Page (the panel appointed as the Examining Authority for the application for Xlinks) undertook the inspection on 1 April 2025.

The USI was undertaken by car and on foot on public roads and footpaths. A route was planned having regard to issues raised in relevant representations, enabling the panel to obtain views of the site of the proposed development. The panel also inspected the venue for future events. The panel's itinerary for the USI is set out below and includes approximate times and locations. The weather was sunny with little to no cloud and good visibility for the entirety of the USI.

9am departed the hotel and started the USI.

- **9.30am** arrived at Westward Ho! and walked along the coastal path towards the landfall construction compound.
- **10.10am** inspected the vicinity of the landfall construction compound.
- **10.45am** returned to Westward Ho!
- **11.05am** arrived and inspected the vicinity of the A39 construction compound.
- **11.15am** arrived at Bideford and walked along the Tarka Trail towards the vicinity of the River Torridge construction compound.
- **11.50am** arrived and inspected the vicinity of the River Torridge construction compound and looked across the river towards the vicinity of the A386 construction compound.
- **12.15pm** returned to Bideford for lunch.
- **1.15pm** arrived and inspected the vicinity of the Gammaton Road compound.
- **1.30pm** drove the perimeter of the converter site, stopping at several viewpoints.
- **2.40pm** arrived at the Park Hotel and inspected the venue.

**3pm** returned to the hotel and finished the USI.
