### Change Application

On 9 January 2026, the Applicant notified the ExA of its intention to submit a Change Application and provided the ExA with a **Change Notification [AS-006]** and **Appendices [AS-007]** relating to the following proposed changes to the Application:

- **Proposed Change 1** - Reduction of Land Acquisition Powers.
- **Proposed Change 2** - Alignment of the CO2 Connection Corridor Landscape Plan with the HyNet CO2 Pipeline Project.
- **Proposed Change 3** - Land Designation Adjustment.
- **Proposed Change 4** - Reduction in Heat Recovery Steam Generator (HRSG) Stack and CCP Absorber Heights.
- **Proposed Change 5** - Contractors’ Facilities Relocation.
- **Proposed Change 6** - Proposed Hardstanding Expansion at Connah’s Quay North Jetty.

The ExA confirmed in writing on 20 January 2026 that he had exercised his discretion and made a procedural decision to accept the Change Notification (paragraph 6, Annex B of the ExA’s ‘Rule 8’ letter), see the **Rule 8 - Notification of timetable for the Examination [PD-010]**.



The Applicant now submits the Change Application, which comprises the following documents:

1. **Document Ref. 10.1 – Change Application Report, Rev 00.** This provides a description of the changes made to the Application and the reasons and need for making those changes.
2. **Document Ref. 10.2 – Change Application Consultation Report, Rev 00.** This explains the consultation that was carried out by the Applicant between 21 January and 18 February 2026 and how the Applicant has had regard to the feedback received.
3. **Document Ref. 10.2.1 – Change Application Consultation Report: Appendices, Rev 00.** These appendices are submitted in support of the Change Application Consultation Report. They have been provided in REDACTED and CONFIDENTIAL form as they contain personal data.
4. **Document Ref. 10.3 - Change Application Report – Schedule of Application Documents, Rev 00.** This document provides the extensive list of documents that have been updated or submitted to reflect the changes.

It should be noted that whilst updating the Application documents to take account of the proposed changes, a number of minor inconsistencies and errors were identified. These have been corrected.

No amendments are needed to the **Draft Development Consent Order (Document Ref. 3.1)** or **Explanatory Memorandum to the draft Development Consent Order (Document Ref. 3.2)** to reflect the changes to the Application.

The changes would not have an impact on securing consents or licences for the Proposed Development or require any new consents or licences.

The changes to the Application do not include any additional compulsory acquisition powers and do not result in any new or different likely significant environmental effects.

The Applicant formally requests that the Change Application is accepted into the Examination. The Applicant would respectfully request that the ExA confirms his decision on the Change Application by **Friday 27 March 2026**.

The Applicant is not able to definitively confirm that Artificial Intelligence has not been used in the preparation of this submission<sup>1</sup>.

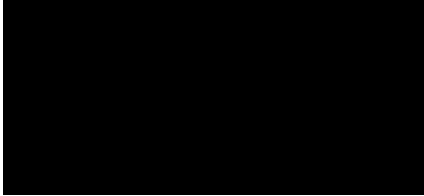
