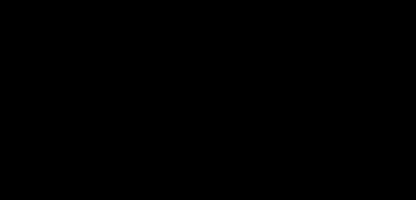
The Applicant is not able to definitively confirm that Artificial Intelligence has not been used in the preparation of this submission¹.
