Hi,

I saw an article on [Deeside.com](https://www.deeside.com) today about the low number of residents attending the meeting regarding this proposal.

I think this is probably because very few residents are even aware of what is being proposed or that a meeting was taking place.

I live in Oakenholt and will be impacted by this if it goes ahead (due to increased pollution, reduced house values etc) but I had no idea this meeting was taking place.

I have received 2 leaflets from Uniper during the time that I have lived in the property (8 years), and these gave the impression that it was just an idea that was being considered. I had no idea this might become a reality.

I am very shocked by the artist's impressions of the site. It will be a complete eyesore for residents and visitors to the area. I am also concerned about the impact on wildlife in the area as there are a lot of birds that nest there. I thought some of this land was protected for the birds as I know you can't walk along some of it due to nesting birds?

I know it might be too late for residents to have a voice now but thought I would send an email anyway to let you know how little awareness there is for this in the surrounding area.
