I am dismayed to learn that the Uniper plant will damage a huge area of the Dee marshes where curlews nest. Developing nesting sites at Gronant will still mean many curlews will die. I believe the drainage into Dee is insufficient and Uniper have made a grave error here. Also nitrogen will be emitted into the Dee so I am wondering how the health of residents in Wirral peninsula will be affected? We were not consulted yet live a few miles away with a view of the power plant. I do not think planning should be granted unless Uniper can address these issues
