Appendix 18-1: Matters Relevant to Human Health Raised Through Consultation

1.1 Overview

- 1.1.1 This technical appendix of the Environmental Statement (ES) summarises the issues raised through consultation regarding Human Health (refer to ES Volume 1, Chapter 18: Human Health [EN010168/APP/6.1]) with statutory consultees outside key publication milestones (scoping, non-statutory consultation, and statutory consultation). Table 1 sets out how the views of the consultation bodies have been taken into account in the environmental studies and design of the Scheme.
