

As a clean energy and energy efficiency engineer of 27 years i find the sheer scale of Lime Down Park to be wholly inappropriate. The average size of a solar farm is 50MW and this is ten times that size. I am a firm believer that we should focus on roof top solar and battery, either off or on grid, and with this in mind I have a £250M scheme starting this year for the education sector to install solar on roof tops and provide grid connected batteries. I have also engaged with the team at Wiltshire Council to focus on Council assets and schools to deploy several MW of solar. This to me seems more prudent and less destructive to the environment and the wellbeing of villagers in the North of the County. 50MW yes, 500MW no.
