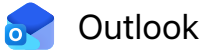

Thank you for your enquiry and I apologise for the delay. We have been unable to locate the submissions you are enquiring about. As a precaution, I requested that our Digital Team undertake a technical review, and they have confirmed that no issues have been identified within our IT systems. As you did not receive either an on-screen confirmation or a confirmation email, the evidence available indicates that your submission was not successfully received.

Regrettably, the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 do not permit an extension to the deadline for the receipt of a Relevant Representation, which means we cannot register you as an interested party. However, I sympathise with your situation, and you may put your comments in an email to be considered by the Examining Authority at the Procedural Deadline A on 9 March 2026.
