

The land subject to the proposed Lime Down Solar Scheme cable run is of significant importance to the farm. It is one of the most productive fields on the farm and estimated to be Grade 2, bordering on Grade 1 land quality.

In addition to the arable cropping, which produced 4 tonnes per acre of winter barley for the past cropping year, plus 2 tonnes per acre of straw, the land is used for winter sheep grazing and supports an SFI scheme.

The accompanying plan shows the cable route (orange) and the additional area being sought for the scheme. This is an extensive area which will materially affect the future productivity and overall nature of the farm.

Heads of Terms negotiations are still on-going and no agreement has yet been reached with Island Green Power or Dalcour Maclaren.
