Question:

Accuracy of the Book of Reference, Land Plans and Points of Clarification Q2

The Book of Reference (BoR) [REP1-011] identifies on a plot by plot basis, all parties who own or occupy land and/or have an interest in or right over the land affected by the proposal, and/or who may be entitled to make a ‘relevant claim’, as defined in section 57 of the Planning Act 2008. Are any Affected Persons or Interested Parties aware of any inaccuracies in the BoR, in the SoR [APP-018] or Land Plans [REP1-004]? If so, please set out what these are and provide the correct details.

Grenergy Response:

Grenergy notes that the latest version of the Book of Reference fails to account for Grenergy’s Category 2 interest in land. The Applicant is aware of the location of Grenergy’s interest within the draft Order limits and should update the Book of Reference accordingly.
