Lime Down Solar Park Development Consent Order – Deadline 6B Submission(s)

Planning Inspectorate Case Reference: EN010168

Further to the updated Rule 8(3) Letter **[PD-013]**, published on 16 July 2026, which established the revised Examination Timetable and introduced Deadline 6B, I am writing to provide the Applicant's submissions for Deadline 6B of the Lime Down Solar Park Development Consent Order Examination.

The documents submitted at Deadline 6B are set out in tabulated form in Appendix A (new documents) and Appendix B (updated documents) of this letter.

Change Application

The Examining Authority (ExA), in its Procedural Decision dated 6 July 2026 **[PD-012]**, confirmed that the Applicant's Change Request, submitted on 24 June 2026, had been accepted into the Examination. The Change Application comprises four proposed changes, including Change 1, which incorporates additional land required to facilitate the emergency access to the Battery Energy Storage System at Lime Down D.



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The Procedural Decision **[PD-012]** also confirmed that a revised Examination Timetable would be issued to accommodate the submission of Relevant Representations (RRs) and Written Representations (WRs) in relation to the Change Application, together with subsequent responses to those representations.

The ExA subsequently issued the updated Rule 8(3) Letter **[PD-013]** on 16 July 2026, establishing the revised Examination Timetable. The revised timetable provided for Deadline 6 on 21 August 2026 for the submission of RRs in relation to the proposed provision for the compulsory acquisition of additional land associated with Change 1 and WRs on the Change Application as a whole, comprising Changes 1 to 4. Deadline 6B provides for responses to those representations.

The ExA accepted and published six valid RRs following the Change Request. The Applicant has therefore responded at Deadline 6B to all matters raised in those six RRs, including where those matters relate to the Scheme more generally rather than specifically to the Change Application.

In respect of the 26 WRs submitted at Deadline 6, given the limited period between Deadline 6 and Deadline 6B, the Applicant has prioritised at Deadline 6B, its responses to matters raised specifically in relation to the Change Application. Where a WR raises matters relating to the Change Application alongside other matters concerning the Scheme, the **Applicant's Response to Relevant Representations and Written Representations Received at Deadline 6 [EN010168/EXAM/9.75]** responds at Deadline 6B to those elements relating to the Change Application.

Any additional matters raised within WRs at Deadline 6 that do not relate to the Change Application will be considered and responded to at Deadline 7. This approach enables representations concerning the Change Application to be addressed at the earliest opportunity, while allowing the Applicant sufficient time to consider and provide appropriate responses to all other matters raised at Deadline 6.



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Responses to Stop Lime Down Deadline 5 submissions

As confirmed in its Deadline 6 submissions, as part of its Deadline 6B submissions, the Applicant has provided responses to Stop Lime Down's Deadline 5 submission **[REP5-130]** Appendices A (Landscape) and C (Spreadsheet of HGV Frequency Fosse Way – Bradfield Cottages).

Response to National Gas Deadline 6 response

The Applicant has provided a response to National Gas Transmission plc's Deadline 6 submission: **Comments on submissions received at Deadline 5 [REP6-077]. See Response to Deadline 6 National Gas Transmission Plc Submission [EN010168/EXAM/9.78].**

Removal of Panels from the southern part of field A1

As noted in the Applicant's cover letter for its Deadline 6 submission, changes were required to a number of documents to account for the removal of panels from the southern part of field A1. In addition to the updated documents submitted at Deadline 6, the Applicant has updated the calculations in the following documents to account for the removal of panels:

- **ES Volume 1, Chapter 8: Landscape and Visual [EN010168/APP/6.1];**
- **ES Volume 3, Appendix 8-6: Assessment of the Effects on the Cotswolds National Landscape and its Special Qualities [EN010168/APP/6.3]; and**
- **Limestone Lowlands Character Assessment [EN010168/EXAM/9.60].**

Use of Artificial Intelligence

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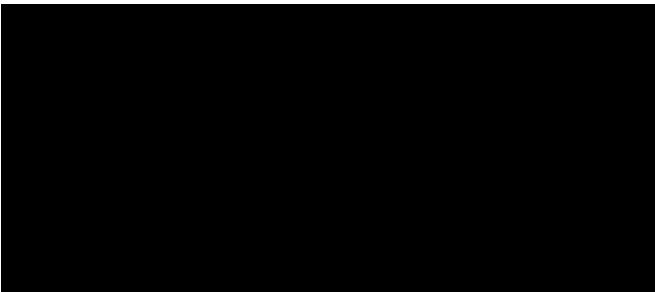
