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# 1. List of Cumulative Schemes

## 1.1. Overview

- 1.1.1. This appendix provides the long list of cumulative schemes which have been identified on the basis of the search criteria set out within Table 1-1.
- 1.1.2. Cumulative Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIPs), which meet the search criteria, are listed within Table 1-2. Planning applications submitted under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and other planning regimes are listed within Table 1-3. Allocations identified from local plans are set out within Table 1-4. Solar schemes within the administrative boundary of Lincolnshire County Council are listed within Table 1-5.
- 1.1.3. Table 1-2, Table 1-3 and Table 1-4 then conclude which cumulative developments have been short-listed for further assessment. All solar schemes above 1MW listed within Table 1-5 have been considered in the cumulative effects assessments for agricultural land use within **ES Chapter 5: Agriculture and Soils** (Doc Ref. 6.1) and **ES Chapter 16: Other Environmental Topics, Section 16.6 Materials and Waste** (Doc Ref 6.1).
- 1.1.4. Table 1-6 lists planning applications which were previously identified in the long-list of cumulative schemes in the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR) or have been raised as part of consultation feedback, however, have now been excluded from the final long-list of cumulative schemes. Reasons for their exclusion are also set out. These include applications where consent has been refused, applications which have been withdrawn, where planning permission has now expired or applications which have been assumed to form part of the existing baseline (and so are assessed as part of the baseline within the main chapters directly) due to the age of the application.
