hedge at left. The Grid Connection Route will pass just in front of farm sheds and hedge in middle distance

Plate 75: Grid Connection Route: north end of Broad Gate, north of Wood Farm livery, facing west across route towards Swindlers Drove. Note spire of Church of St Paul (1306702), centre, and chimneys of Spalding Power Station, right



Plate 76: Grid Connection Route: Delgate Bank south of former railway - looking south-west from New England Farm (MLI124931, MLI116358 & MLI116357) across route. An OHL tower will be in the foreground, some 150m from the road.



Plate 77: Grid Connection Route: Long Lane north of B1165 - looking south-east across route to The Beeches (MLI123192). Grid Connection Route runs left to right just into this field, with a tower next to the bush



Plate 78: Grid Connection Route: Whirl Gate south of B1165 - looking north along route towards Austendyke Road



Plate 79: Grid Connection Route: eastwards turn of West Gate - looking west past The Cottage. Route passes a short distance behind the house



Plate 80: Grid Connection Route: Delgate Bank north of Swanpens Farm (Swampen Farm, MLI122967) - looking east across route towards The Cottage and large farm buildings



Plate 81: Grid Connection Route: Delgate Bank north of Roman Road and south of Swan Pens Farm - looking south-east towards route, which will cross between the two right hand pylons. Concrete road leads to sewage works



Plate 82: Grid Connection Route: north of Roman Road, looking east across Grid Connection Route where it crosses Delgate Bank road, with Broad Gate beyond.



Plate 83: Grid Connection Route: Broadgate Drove south of greenhouses, looking southwest along route
