The ExA will then ask any questions it may have in respect to the oral and written cases made by the Applicant and other IPs.

3.3 Effects for Ecology and Biodiversity

The ExA will ask the Applicant to give a ten-minute summary of its case with regard to Ecology and Biodiversity effects, including:

- a) Effects on internationally designated sites and protected species
- b) Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) fire safety and drainage
- Effects on groundwater including aquifer and decommissioning impacts
- d) Ancient Woodland buffer zones

The ExA will invite IPs (five minutes each IP) to comment on the Applicant's position in respect of ecology and biodiversity effects.

The ExA will then ask any questions it may have in respect of the oral and written cases made by the Applicant and other IPs.

3.4 Effects for Traffic and Transport

The ExA will invite IPs (five minutes each IP) to comment on the Applicant's position in respect of traffic and transport effects.

The ExA will then ask any questions it may have in respect of the oral and written cases made by the Applicant and other IPs.

3.5 Effects for Built Heritage and Archaeology

Guidance under the Planning Act 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 provides that it is for the ExA to probe, test and assess the evidence through direct questions of persons making oral representations at Hearings. Questioning at the Hearing will be led by the ExA. Cross questioning of a person giving evidence by another person will only be permitted if the ExA decides it is necessary to ensure representations are adequately tested or that an IP has had a fair chance to puts its case.
