Response to Examining Authority First Questions by Bozeat Parish Council 18th November 2025

Introduction

This document contains the Bozeat Parish Council response to the Examining Authority first questions.

Q.16.0.3 Viewpoint and Photomontage Locations

We feel that because of the chosen layout of the panels and in order to conform to the Rochdale Envelope it is necessary to relocate VP35 further along the footpath to where the footpath meets the access track between fields GF1 and GF4.

Q20.0.9 Highways Safety – Bozeat

The applicant's response to this does not acknowledge that the cemetery, the parking spaces for several Easton Lane properties, the new-build Ahern Close and a number of individual properties are on the opposite side of Link 81 to the footpaths meaning that pedestrians always have to cross the road. Residents of the Ahern Close development and the individual properties would have to do so to reach all facilities within the village including the village shop, school, churches, community church hall and playing fields.

The applicant's response also does not address the safety of non-motorised users of the road to Easton Maudit.
