1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Document

- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared to provide the Examining Authority (ExA) with the latest position on Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) between Island Green Power (IGP) (the 'Applicant') and statutory consultees, statutory undertakers and other Interested Parties (the 'parties') in relation to the proposed Green Hill Solar Project (the 'Scheme').
- 1.1.2 This document provides a position on the commonality on specific points between SoCGs up to Deadline 3 (being 17 December 2025).
- 1.1.3 The Applicant will, for each deadline during the course of the Examination, update this Statement as a record of the progress being made with the various parties. When sufficient progress has been made on agreements between parties, this document will also discuss those areas of commonality between parties to enable the efficient resolution and focusing in on the remaining issues.

1.2 Structure of this Document

- 1.2.1 This Statement of Commonality is structured as follows:
 - Section 2 details the structure of each SoCG document. Table 2.1 provides a full list of SoCGs being produced and offers an overview of the status of each SoCG being submitted to Deadline 2;
 - Section 3 sets out the commonality between SoCGs; and
 - Section 4 provides a narrative on specific topic areas for each SoCG being progressed.



2 Statement of Common Ground

2.1 Structure of SoCGs

- 2.1.1 Each SoCG adopts a standard format to ensure consistency in the approach taken to documenting those matters agreed, matters subject to ongoing discussion or matters not agreed.
- 2.1.2 Each SoCG is structured as follows:
 - Section 1 provides an introduction to the SoCG, identifies the relevant parties and describes the purpose of the document;
 - Section 2 summarises the parties' engagement undertaken to date; and
 - Section 3 details those matters agreed, those matters under discussion and those matters which have not been agreed.




3 Commonality

3.1 Overview

- 3.1.1 This section of the Statement provides an overview of the topics covered in the SoCGs. **Table 3.2** presents, at a high level, where there is commonality in the topics discussed between the Applicant and the parties, or where matters are progressing through discussion, or where matters discussed have reached a final position of 'Not Agreed'.
- 3.1.2 Where a topic is not relevant to a particular party, the cell has been greyed out. Where the topic is relevant to the party, the status is shown as follows:

- 3.1.3 The colour of each cell corresponds to the status figure (as above) in each individual SoCG.
- 3.1.4 At Deadline 2, the Applicant has shared draft SoCGs with a number of parties and is awaiting feedback from them. Therefore, where the Applicant considers there to be a high degree of certainty over matters being agreed and is waiting for confirmation, they are marked as green in **Table 3.2.**
- 3.1.5 Following the Summary of Commonality in **Table 3.2**, **Section 3.2** outlines the principal outstanding matters which are subject to further discussion before a final position can be reached.

4 Positions at Deadline 2

4.1.1 This section provides a summary of the position reached across all SoCGs being progressed and submitted to Deadline 2. The Applicant will continue to engage with those parties through the examination on matters which are ongoing.

4.2 North Northamptonshire Council

- 4.2.1 The matters recorded in the SoCG have been subject to discussion, through monthly catchups, between the Applicant and North Northamptonshire Council (NNC) as well as some topic specific meetings e.g. landscape and visual impact, and historic environment. Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant has received comments from NNC on the 11 December 2025. These comments have moved four matters from under discussion to agreed (LVIA-09 Landscape Receptors: Value; CH-02 Cultural Heritage Baseline Conditions; TA-06 Prow and TA-07 Permissive Paths). The Applicant is seeking to arrange a meeting with NNC to follow up on the comments received and to progress further matters.
- 4.2.2 The Applicant's landscape consultant is meeting with NNC's landscape consultant on the 19 December 2025 to further progress landscape matters which are still under discussion. The matters listed as agreed in **Table 3.2** are based on the current position of NNC on the listed matters.
- 4.2.3 The main matters subject to further discussion relate to planning, landscape and visual impact, ecology, hydrology, heritage, transport, arboriculture, soils and agriculture and the Draft DCO **[EX3/GH3.1_C]**.
- 4.2.4 An updated SoCG will be submitted for Deadline 4 where it is anticipated a number of ongoing matters will become agreed.

4.3 West Northamptonshire Council

- 4.3.1 The matters recorded in the SoCG have been subject to discussion, through monthly catchups, between the Applicant and West Northamptonshire Council (WNC) as well as some topic specific meetings e.g. landscape and visual impact, historic environment and transport. Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant has requested comments from WNC on that draft and the Applicant's Response to Local Impact Reports [REP2-049]. Comments are awaited and the Applicant expects to provide a further update at Deadline 4.
- 4.3.2 The Applicants landscape consultant is meeting with NNC's landscape consultant on 19 December 2025 to further progress landscape matters which are still under discussion. The matters listed as agreed in **Table 3.2** are based on the current position of WNC on the listed matters.
- 4.3.3 The main matters subject to further discussion relate to scheme description, energy need, planning statement, alternative and design evolution, EIA residual effects, landscape and visual impact, ecology, hydrology (LLFA), minerals, heritage, transport, noise, socioeconomic, tourism and recreation, arboriculture, soils and agriculture and the Draft DCO [EX3/GH3.1 C].
- 4.3.4 An updated SoCG will be submitted for Deadline 4 where it is anticipated a number of ongoing matters will become agreed.



4.4 Milton Keynes City Council

- 4.4.1 The matters recorded in the SoCG have been subject to discussion, through monthly catchup meetings, between the Applicant and Milton Keynes City Council (MKCC) as well as some topic specific meetings e.g. landscape and visual impact. Detailed discussions on cultural heritage and ecology and biodiversity matters have also taken place. Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant has requested comments from MKCC on that draft and the Applicant's Response to Local Impact Reports [REP2-049]. Comments are awaited and the Applicant expects to provide a further update at Deadline 4. The Applicant has requested a meeting with the MKCC landscape officer to discuss matters but this still hasn't been arranged. The matters listed as agreed in Table 3.2 are based on the current position of MKCC on the listed matters.
- 4.4.2 The main matters subject to further discussion relate to alternative and design evolution, EIA residual effects, landscape and visual impact, ecology, hydrology, transport, arboriculture and the Draft DCO [REP1-008].
- 4.4.3 An updated SoCG will be submitted for Deadline 4 where it is anticipated a number of ongoing matters will become agreed matters.

4.5 Historic England

The Applicant has submitted a draft to the party and held a meeting with them on the 8 December 2025 to discuss wording within the Archaeological Mitigation Strategy and is waiting comments back. The matters listed as agreed in **Table 3.2** are based on extensive discussions between the parties with the high likelihood of them being agreed.

4.6 The Environment Agency

- 4.6.1 Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant received comments on the 16 December 2025. These comments have moved three matters from under discussion to agreed (EB-08 Avoidance of coarse fish spawning period; HYD-03 Surface Water Flooding and HYD-05 Surface Water Management). The Applicant is in the process of reviewing these comments and is seeking to arrange a meeting with Environment Agency to follow up on the comments received and to progress further matters. from the Environment Agency on the draft SoCG with comments still awaited. The Parties are in agreement on some matters within the draft SoCG relating to legislation and consultation for Ecology and Biodiversity, and WFD, Design and Surface Water Management for Hydrology and Flood Risk.
- 4.6.2 The Applicant will continue to liaise with the Environment Agency, and it is hoped that a large number of matters will be agreed by Deadline 4.

4.7 Natural England

4.7.1 Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant received comments from Natural England on the 15 December 2025. These comments have moved all matters except for Methodology: Definition of FLL and Proposed Mitigation for wintering birds remaining under discussion. These final matters require Natural England to review survey data relating to these matters. The



Application responded on the 16 December 2025 to signpost where that information can be found within the DCO submission.

4.7.2 Following the review of this data it is hoped that all matters can be agreed by Deadline 4.

4.8 National Highways

4.8.1 There has been progression on matters with National Highways since Deadline 2 with all matters now agreed except for matters relating to the Draft DCO [EX3/GH3.1_C], specifically protective provisions. The matters listed as agreed are set out in in **Table 3.2**. Discussions are ongoing in respect of the protective provisions.

4.9 Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service

4.9.1 All matters have been agreed between the parties by Deadline 2. A signed SoCG was submitted at Deadline 2 [REP2-063].

4.10 Anglian Water Services

- 4.10.1 Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant has requested comments from Anglian Water on the draft SoCG with comments still awaited. The matters listed as agreed in **Table 3.2** are based on discussions between the parties on the high likelihood of them being agreed.
- 4.10.2 The Applicant will continue to liaise with Anglian Water, and it is hoped that a large number of matters will be agreed by Deadline 4.

4.11 National Grid Electricity Transmission

- 4.11.1 Following the submission of the draft SoCG at Deadline 2, the Applicant has requested comments from National Grid on the draft SoCG with comments still awaited. The matters listed as agreed in **Table 3.2** are based on discussions between the parties on the high likelihood of them being agreed.
- 4.11.2 Discussions relate to agreeing the wording of the protective provisions and the Draft DCO **[EX3/GH3.1_C]** for the benefit of National Grid, along with the consideration of National Grid schemes which they have raised.
- 4.11.3 The Applicant will continue to liaise with National Grid, and it is hoped that a large number of matters will be agreed by Deadline 4.
