Further to the Secretary of State's request at paragraphs 10 and 11 of the consultation letter dated 28 August 2026 in respect of paragraph 97(4) of Part 8 of Schedule 15 (protective provisions for the protection of Cadent Gas Limited), I can confirm that paragraph 97(4) of Part 8 of Schedule 15 should be consistent with the West Burton Solar Project Order 2025 and should be amended to read as follows:

"(4) Any agreement or consent granted by Cadent under paragraph 100 or any other paragraph of this Part of this Schedule, will not be taken to constitute agreement under sub-paragraph (1)."
