Green Hill Solar – Request for Information

Thank you for your email of 2 September 2026 notifying Natural England of the letter from the Secretary of State, dated 28 August 2026, requesting further information from Natural England.

Natural England is a non-departmental public body. Our statutory purpose is to ensure that the natural environment is conserved, enhanced, and managed for the benefit of present and future generations, thereby contributing to sustainable development.

We note the Secretary of State's specific question to Natural England as follows:

Changes to the draft Development Consent Order 8.

In response to the Secretary of State's most recent request for information, the Applicant produced an updated Schedule of Changes to the Draft Development Consent Order [C1-014]. In this, the Applicant included a proposed update to Article 6 (Disapplication and modification of legislation, etc.) in response to comments made by Natural England during the Examination of the Lime Down Solar Project (EN010168). Natural England is invited to comment on the wording of this requirement, and the suitability of adding this requirement into this Development Consent Order.

Natural England has reviewed the proposed update to Article 6 ((Disapplication and modification of legislation, etc.) and is satisfied with the wording as set out. We have no concerns around adding this requirement into the Development Consent Order.
