
Please note that the Accompanied Site Visit (ASI) took place on 28 April 2026. A comment received by the Applicant during the ASI regarding a formatting error in the Habitat Regulations Appropriate Assessment Report has resulted in the preparation and submission of Rev. 3 at Deadline 4.

The Applicant has submitted the Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) with National Highways (Document Ref. 9.4) and the Internal Drainage Board (Document Ref. 9.5) which have been signed by the counterparties. The Applicant has not been able to sign both SoCGs by Deadline 4 and will resubmit both SoCGs at Deadline 5 which have also been signed by the Applicant.
