REQUEST TO WITHDRAW PROJECT

WALPOLE FLEXIBLE GENERATION PROJECT - EN0110009

On behalf of Walpole Flexible Generation Limited (the Applicant), I am writing to provide formal notification that the Applicant has decided to withdraw Walpole Flexible Generation Project from the Pre-Application stage of the Development Consent Order (DCO) process for Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects. The project was being promoted as a flexible generation facility with associated energy storage infrastructure.

This decision has been made after careful consideration of the project's development pathway and the Applicant's broader strategic priorities. While the underlying need for flexible and dispatchable energy infrastructure remains, the Applicant considers that the current scheme no longer represents the preferred approach for achieving its objectives.

The Applicant would like to thank the Planning Inspectorate and all other interested parties who have engaged with the project during the pre-application process.

I would be grateful if the Planning Inspectorate could update its records accordingly and note that the Applicant is no longer progressing the Walpole Flexible Generation Project.
