

Further to Anglian Water's Relevant Representation [REP-003], this Written Representation is provided to update the Examining Authority on the status of the matters raised in that representation and Anglian Water's ongoing engagement with the Applicant.

As set out in the Relevant Representation, Anglian Water's principal concerns relate to:

- the identification and protection of our assets within the Order Limits,
- non-domestic water supply including whether a water resources assessment is required,
- the need for appropriate protective provisions within the draft Development Consent Order, and
- a number of environmental and operational matters requiring further discussion and clarification.

These matters were raised in Anglian Water's statutory capacity as water and sewerage undertaker for the area and reflected points previously identified through the pre-application process and statutory consultation

The matters raised in our Relevant Representation have since been carried forward into a draft Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) between the Applicant and Anglian Water, which was shared on 5 May 2026. The draft SoCG has been reviewed by Anglian Water and returned to the Applicant and forms the mechanism through which the parties are seeking to record matters agreed and identify those matters which remain under discussion. It is noted that the Examining Authority has also included questions for the Applicant regarding the status of Protective Provisions (Q5.0.15), Water Resource Assessment (Q8.0 12), and design considerations resulting from the location of existing utilities (Q14.0.11) in ExQ1 [PD-007].

For completeness, Anglian Water confirms that its objection in relation to the Protective Provisions has been withdrawn following further discussion with the Applicant. Anglian Water's position on that matter, and the reasons why that objection is no longer maintained, have been set out separately in response to Examining Authority's Written Questions 1 (ExQ1) [PD-007]. The remaining matters identified in the Relevant Representation are therefore those which continue to be addressed through the draft Statement of Common Ground and ongoing engagement between the parties.
