ASI Thursday 10th September, point to be noted, question.

Possible redundant infrastructure, Pylons left in the landscape at Bartholomew's Hills.

If a National Grid substation were to be built in the current planned location and a National Grid line diversion built to make a connection, it has been suggested that a number of the existing pylons will be no longer required, so will become redundant.

If this application for a DCO were to receive approval, may we ask what can be done about this potential redundant infrastructure. Whose responsibility would they become, would they still belong to the National Grid, could they not be pressured to remove redundant infrastructure from the landscape, if redundant and left in place along with newly constructed pylons this will be increasing the impact on the historic landscape, it could be regarded as industrial litter! We would respectfully ask for some clarity on this point please and would hope all efforts were made to remove any unwanted structures from the landscape if they were indeed no longer required as energy infrastructure.
