The Scheme is located south of Norwich and north of Harleston, with the Scheme concentrated east of Long Stratton, with an additional cluster of Solar PV electricity generating stations located south of Great Moulton. The Scheme is near to the villages of Pulham Market, Hempnall, Tasburgh, Silver Green, Saxlingham Nethergate, Woodton, Brooke and Seething.
