• The setting has been defined specifically for the
Bramford to Twinstead Project and should not be
applied to other projects or proposals.
• The setting does not have a defined
geographical border and is therefore shown with a
graduated shade and is shown at a suitable
scale based on how this has been defined.
• The setting is only defined for the northern and
western boundaries of the AONB, as this is where
the Bramford to Twinstead Reinforcement is
located.
