Re: LPA Consultation Response on a Non-Material Change Application to The National Grid (North London Reinforcement Project) Order 2014

Dear Secretary of State,

Thank you for consulting the London Borough of Haringey on the above Non-Material Change to The National Grid (North London Reinforcement Project) Order 2014.

As LPA, we have undertaken our own consultation, with in-house officer specialists, as well as making the application and information available to the members of the public via the Council's Public Register, and erecting site notices in the locality. This is in addition to the public consultation exercise undertaken by National Grid.

We have not received any representations from the public in response to the consultation.

Whilst we do not object to the proposal as LPA, the following is asked to be considered:

1. Any construction works movements, particularly oversized movements, should occur outside of peak hours to minimise the impact on the highways network in Haringey; and
2. The visual and environmental/ecological impacts of retaining trees within the revised proposal; and also the visual impact of the additional pylon on the surrounding area, considering there are other similar pylons in the area which are also needed to perform a statutory function of providing energy to residents and businesses.
