Amendment to the appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on 23 April 2025. On 27 May 2025 a document was published confirming that Sarah Holmes (lead), Richard Hunt, Steven Rennie, Nancy Thomas and Simon Warder had been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application for the Sea Link project.
