I am making this representation late because, NG themselves say in their letter of 05 September, they have never contacted me, even though I live in my caravan just on the border of the Order Limits on a lateral and a lateral and late

A member of the public has taken the trouble to visit me, find out my name and explain what is proposed. NG have never done this - they clearly don't even know my name

From what I have been told, there will be work going on for more than a year to construct a massive converter station across the road to the back of where I live and there will be lots of heavy machinery digging up the fields across from where I live, work that might go on for more than a year, 7 days a week. I came here to live for a peaceful life.

The member of the public that visited me explained that the road on which I live is one of the proposed access roads for the work they are planning. The road will be used for heavy machinery to and from a construction compound, probably near to where I live. The little lane where I live is not 2-way traffic and is a dead end. It's totally unsuitable for heavy traffic and I don't want lorries and machinery rumbling past me all day, every day. I've not even been told what the plans are by National Grid.

I am also not at all happy about the damage to the environment in Pegwell Bay and on Minster Marshes - just over the way from me.

I thought these areas had protection, RAMSAR, SSSI and its a National Nature Reserve too. David Attenborough opened it.

I really object to this plan, it could ruin my life.

I'll be moving over my dead body! I have nowhere else to go!
