

Further to my previous submission I wish to raise the fact that building on the marsh would have a huge impact on not only this area but it is impossible to judge the impact on the Stour and the movement of water through to Canterbury and beyond. Every year the marshes flood as far as the railway line and on occasions past it to the houses of Minster. Thinking that a huge concrete block will not affect this River is frankly bizarre. This will affect wildlife which has been nurtured back over many years and protected. It will affect tourism and become a blot on the landscape.

If the go ahead was given it will create traffic issues from step one to the end as Thanet roads cannot deal with the amount we have already. Marsh road is just a minor track and would have to be properly constructed to take the lorry movements. This alone will affect the wildlife.

Also I urge you to look at this application with a view to over planned developments in the area and you will see that cumulatively Thanet is being destroyed and it is pushing people away.

Having watched the two meetings there is so much to consider but surely the destruction planned for a protected area should not be entertained.
