My name is Richard Bodek and I live at North Warren – close to the proposed cable route of SEALINK heading across from Aldeburgh towards Friston & Saxmundam.

We moved here permanently in January 2020 for a quiet retirement phase of life in a rural setting with wildlife / moderate traffic / dark skies / closer to nature

We knew of Sizewell and Scottish Power schemes – but NOT the National Grid Schemes!

Of course we are here today to talk about Sealink it is impossible to consider this in isolation because of what is already happening on the Energy Coast – SIZEWELL & SCOTTISH POWER PLUS THE OTHERS in consultation and planning stages: SEALINK / LIONLINK / FRISTON POWERHUB / SUFFOLK WATER SCHEME FOR SIZEWELL

SO AM I BEING A NIMBY? – MORE LEARNED INDIVIDUALS THAN I TELL ME THAT I AM NOT BECAUSE I AM NOT SAYING DO NOT HAVE ENERGY SCHEMES – I AM SAYING THERE ARE ALTERNATIVE OFFSHORE SOLUTIONS AND BROWNFIELD INDUSTRIALISE SITES

AT A CONSULTATION MEETING IN ALDEBURGH I ASKED A NATIONAL GRID REPRESENTATIVE WHY OFFSHORE OPTIONS WERE NOT BEING LOOKED AT – HIS SURPRISING RESPONSE WAS THAT THEY HAD NOT BEEN ASKED TO LOOK AT SUCH OPTIONS!

My Observations are

CUMULATIVE IMPACT –

Suffolk Coastal MP Jenny Riddell Carpenter recently commented at Westminster:

"A remarkable lack of co-ordination / no attempt to plan for cumulative impact / area of the country mostly served by B roads and country lanes / remarkable that developers are being allowed to bring forward these proposals when off-shore alternatives could easily have been considered"

TOURISM - major employer in this part of the world!

Visitors are already shocked by the Sizewell impact – will they come back again –

Tourism/ Hospitality is a major employer on the East Coast of Suffolk

TRAFFIC & TRAVEL

Thousands of heavy vehicle movements / Our roads are constantly being diverted / journeys are slower – it is stressful and constantly changing.

HEALTH & WELLBEING

Existing energy schemes are already causing stress and anxiety – let alone the anxiety of what the next 2 or maybe 3 schemes will add.

Where we live is being changed hugely – and it feels like we have no control over it – it is being "done to us"

It is genuinely depressing!

WILDLIFE

AONBs & SSIs being carved up

22,000 trees reportedly felled so far to build SizewellC

Of course new ones being planted to replace – but how long to become mature – assuming they are watered?

Wildlife being forced to move – deer being displaced / migration routes disrupted

Behind our own paddock – Turtle Doves return every year. Disruption threatens this "at risk "species. Does anyone care?

Rutting stags in the fields behind us – where will they go?

In conclusion – IT IS TOO MUCH IN ONE SMALL AREA!
