

I spoke at the open floor meeting at Snape but I would like to make a final plea for our beleaguered wildlife. Despite the planning inspectorate recommending refusing Sizewell c planning application, the government overruled that and rode roughshod over our protected areas, consequently we have lost so much of our precious habitat for our wildlife. WE were misled over size well c as to the scale of the devastation it would cause and important information, such as the need for a seawall and new water supply were withheld from the application. We must not allow further losses of environmentally sensitive area's when offshore makes more sense. The Suffolk cOastal area has been seriously impacted by sizewell c it wouldn't be right to allow further destruction to this area.

There is a lot of talk regarding green options but it cannot be green if our environment, our wildlife and our communities are sacrificed to yet another ill conceived scheme.

On a personal level I find witnessing the annihilation of our special area to be extremely distressing and is causing my mental health to suffer. I have a serious illness and high stress levels are having a negative impact on my health.

The Suffolk Coastal area has already massively contributed to helping overcome our energy crisis but enough is enough, we should not be expected to do any more. Please do the right thing and turn this planning application down.
