

I am a local resident directly affected by the Sea Link project responding to the disgraceful Applicant's Thematic response to my RR. My major concerns are long term construction noise and disruption especially to Benhall Bridge and the ensuing safety aspects. Ecological and landscape harm in particular to the market town of Saxmundham. The applicant has repeatedly been lazy in not producing evidence just relying on desk top modelling. Working over weekends and holidays must be restricted for the well being and mental health of local people. The shocking 26 meter high converter station will be a blot on the Saxmundham landscape forever and cannot realistically be mitigated. Local roads are unsuitable for HGV's due to their narrowness. Emergency services to hospitals will be severely impacted with possible loss of life. East Suffolk cannot endure further damage to protected ANOB, SSSI, SPA .

I am concerned by the failure of SeaLink to fully consider Cumulative Impact.

I therefore most strongly oppose this project as it stands. The Examining Authority should insist on avoidance of sensitive areas, binding community protection and better coordination or refuse consent.
