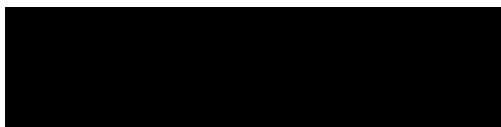

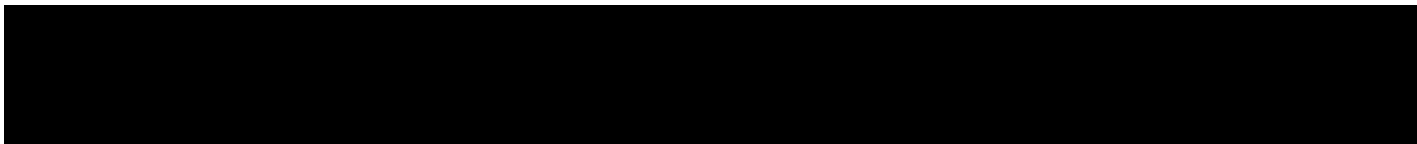
**ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited, East Anglia ONE North Limited and East Anglia TWO Limited’s
Deadline 3 Submission – response to ExQ1**

- 1.1 We refer to the above Project and confirm we are instructed by ScottishPower Renewables (UK) Limited (“**SPR**”), East Anglia ONE North Limited (“**EA1NL**”) and East Anglia TWO Limited (“**EA2L**”).
- 1.2 SPR is the parent company of EA1NL, who has the benefit of the East Anglia ONE North Offshore Wind Farm Order 2022 (“**EA1N**”), and EA2L, who has the benefit of the East Anglia TWO Offshore Wind Farm Order 2022 (“**EA2**”). EA1N, EA2L and SPR are interested parties to the examination of the application for development order for the Project (the “**Examination**”).
- 1.3 The examining authority issued its first written questions (“**ExQ1**”) [PD-017] on 17 December 2025. While no questions were specifically directed towards EA1NL, EA2L or SPR, EA1NL and EA2L are statutory undertakers for the purposes of question 1GEN39 and therefore our clients have provided a response to that query overleaf.

EA1NL and EA2L reiterate that the development of appropriate protective provisions to manage the interface between their assets and Sea Link will be imperative. The interface between EA1N and EA2 and Sea Link is reasonably complex and will require bespoke protective provisions. To that end, SPR is preparing a draft suite of protective provisions which will be provided to NGET.</p>
