

The limited plans that have been published so far are not fit for purpose. The public should be provided with full detailed plans of what is now being discussed. Those who live near the area including myself will be constantly subject to noise and pollution. Traffic will jam up the highways with mega machinery causing even more pollution. The health of the towns people will suffer. The wildlife will be drastically affected. The hoverports fragile ecosystem, the salt marsh and the wildlife that have made it their home will be threatened and the surface of the hoverport will break up under the heavy machinery releasing the colliery spoil. No ecological surveys by National Grid have yet been done.

I find the so called plans submitted by the National Grid to be totally inadequate and utterly unfit for purpose. Following the so called planned move to come ashore on the old hovercraft site things have got even worse. The damage to wildlife in the environmentally sensitive Pegwell Bay Area is going to be enormous and there are no plans published so far to mitigate this devastating environmental disaster
