

I am writing this comment to raise my objections to the use of the Hoverport for access to the intertidal mudflats at Pegwell Bay in relation to the Sealink project.

I find hard to believe that National Grid have no information/knowledge about the colliery waste materials used for foundations for the Hoverport

National Grid conclusion that significant effects in relation to geology and hydro geology from existing contamination are unlikely, minor and not significant to cause any permanent damage are yet another example of their arrogance and lack of concern to themselves and irrelevant to them.

What environmental surveys have led to this conclusion remains a mystery to me.
