1. The flood risk on the lower half of Minster which already has a flooding problem will be exacerbated as the millions of litres of storm water the marshes hold will no longer exist.
2. Wild life, birds and the seal colony will be interrupted and displaced. This is a scandalous abuse of a Wildlife Conservation Area.
3. Roads in the area will be blocked and destroyed for a number of years with heavy construction.
4. The residents in the area to date have been completely ignored as if their own opinions do not matter. There is an overwhelming local desire for this not to go ahead.
5. The upheaval and pollution this is going to cause in a Nature Reserve is totally unacceptable.
6. The ecology of the surrounding area will be change beyond recognition for many years into the future.
7. There is no reason why the project cannot be built a bit further down the coast towards Dover where a converter station is needed more to supply ferries and buses in the port.
8. There will be a substantial loss of Grade 1 farmland which is already being eroded in the South East and especially Thanet with the unchecked building boom which is currently going on.
