This email refers to Document reference number 7.5.1.2 of the OCTMandTP Kent

Dear Sir.

We note for the above document that there is no mention of Canterbury and District Angling Association in your notes, and specifically under note 2.2.5. We have a 5 year lease agreement of which 4 years and 4 months are remaining between the Land Owner and the CDAA. We have, at present up to 1200 members who could potentially want to access this site in pursuit of their paid up membership to the Association.

Access is gained from Ebbsfleet Lane North, over the level crossing and turning immediately right onto Brook Lane. We have a locked gate on Brook Lane which we control, which in turn leads to our two fishing lakes.

Brook Lane is a track lane and subject to potholing by traffic. CDAA maintains this track and once a year, when dry, fill the potholes in. The heavy and abnormal amount of traffic from National Grid Contractors has added to these potholes along with bankside damage. NG have made a concerted effort to fill some of the holes and reinforce parts of the bank. However, we feel more damage has been done than repaired, especially when packing up in wet weather.

Please log our interest in this matter and refer to us in any necessary documentation.
