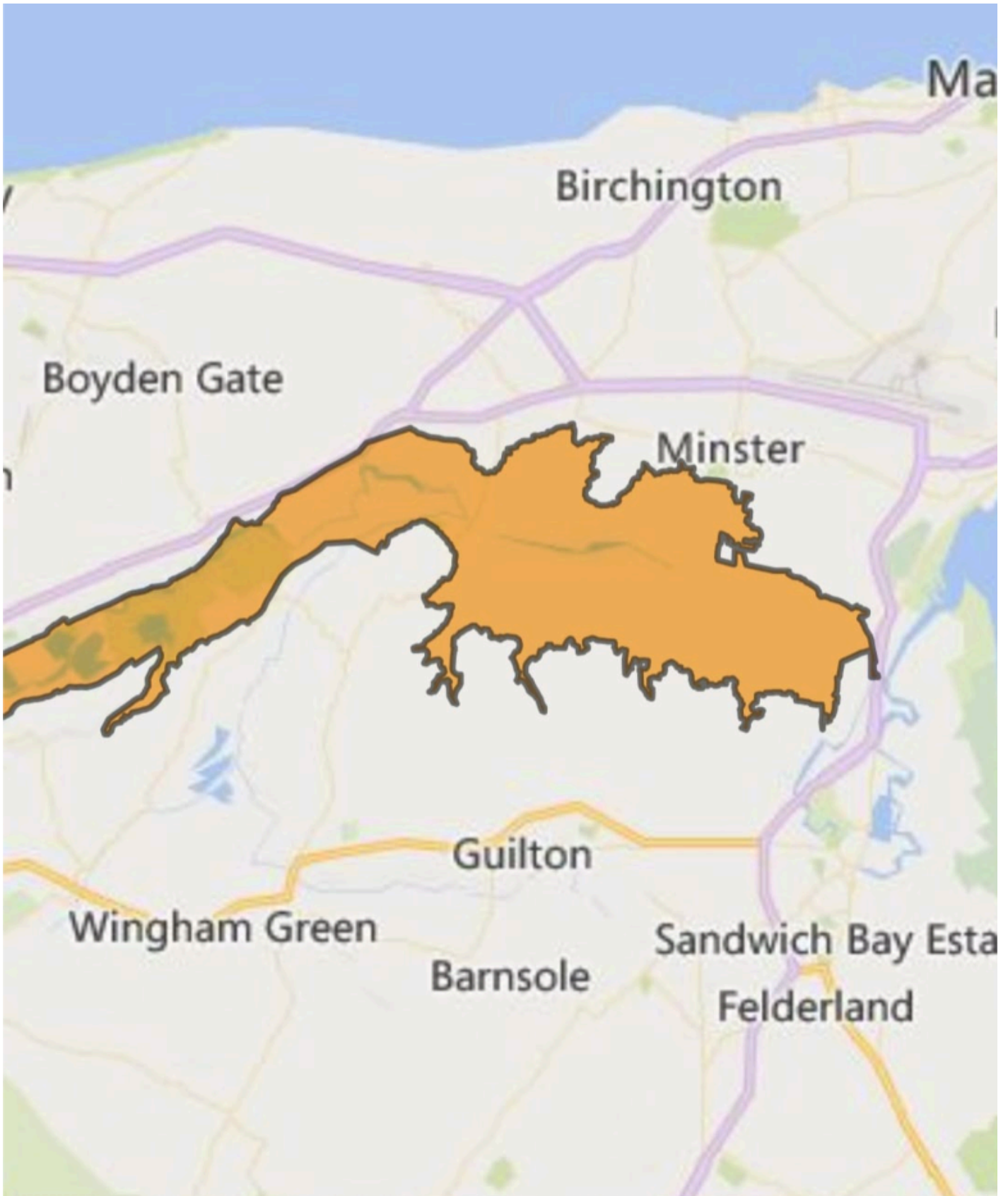

We would also ask you to note that today the Environment Agency has issued a flood warning that encompasses the Lower Stour (see below). This is based on desk data - and will not show the extent of flooding that is heading downriver into the already saturated fields. However, you can see the importance of the marshes as a whole for the soakaway of upriver flooding.

As you know, we think that the choice of location for this build will be an engineering nightmare, an expensive mistake and an ecological disaster in the making.
