

I write as the councillor to Kelsale & Yoxford, thus being at the northern end of the Saxmundham A12 junctions. My comments are as that of a strategic project manager with intrinsic design and space/transformational management skills.

Benhall Bridge/Access to Sealink site - this concept and how to execute it are wholly wrong, and i am aware that the non practicable points have been flushed out at length.

Suffolk County Council's suggestion (pg 12) Comp Acq Hearing 1 is progress but i remain of the opinion that the solution is other - that is to build a new road at the north entrance to Saxmundham that goes over the Fromus and over the railway to site via a round about that supports Saxmundham with the legacy of a community infrastructure asset. Currently the town will receive nothing by way of progress yet the traffic for years will impact the town if now revised with more ambition.
