SOUTH EAST ANGLIA LINK (SEA LINK) PROJECT (EN020026) – ADDITIONAL SUBMISSION

National Highways' Deadline 2 submission, dated 28 November 2025, raised concerns regarding the potential impact of construction traffic on the operation of the Strategic Road Network (SRN) at Seven Hills Roundabout where the A12 and A14 intersect. I can confirm that the Applicant has provided satisfactory evidence to assure National Highways that the additional traffic can be expected to be accommodated without adverse impacts.

National Highways met with the Applicant on 12 December 2025 to discuss the matter and the Applicant provided detailed evidence during and following the meeting, which provided satisfactory assurance that there are not expected to be adverse impacts on the SRN arising from the Development. This was confirmed in the Applicant's Deadline 3 response on 9 January 2026 in Document REP3-069, the Applicant's Response to Written first Questions, specifically in response to Questions 1TT6 and 1TT18.



National Highways is therefore content to withdraw its objection to the Development.
