Dear Sir/ Madam,

I am registered as an interested party regarding the Sea Link Project (Registered party reference number = [REDACTED]).

I understand that there is a proposal from Suffolk County Council to access the Sea Link site near Saxmundham via a Northern Access Route utilising the Sizewell Link Road (B1122). This certainly seems like a better solution than the previous proposal to access via the B1121 which would be hugely disruptive in that the bridge crossing the railway line at Benhall is not structurally able to handle such large vehicles and any work to replace or upgrade this bridge would significantly disrupt residents and businesses. The proposed alternative Northern Access Route from the Sizewell Link Road will be utilising new infrastructure built to accommodate large vehicles and therefore be a more suitable and sustainable access route.

There is, of course, still a question about the initial decision to site Sea Link near Saxmundham. If the Northern Access Route is adopted, then it would be worth considering siting Sea Link on Leiston Airfield which is a much more suitable site.
