I am writing to bring to your attention several concerns regarding the impact of the SeaLink project on our farmland. We anticipate the loss of more than 100 acres of productive farmland as a result of this project, which represents a significant setback for our business. Even during the preparatory investigation phase, we have already experienced considerable damage. The loss of crops, compromised field structure, and equipment damage due to inadequate reinstatement work have all adversely affected our operations.

Looking ahead, we are particularly concerned about the plans for future reinstatement of farmland and the creation of temporary drainage ponds in arable fields. These measures will render the affected areas unfarmable for at least five to ten years, posing substantial challenges to the sustainability of our business.

I trust these points illustrate the urgency and scale of the issues we are facing. We would appreciate your attention to these matters and look forward to discussing potential solutions to mitigate the impact.
