William Notcutt Estates thanks the ExA for following up on the previous submission (Rep5-210) and inviting us to provide details. Point 2 endures; that the construction compound would have less deleterious impact upon us and the operation of our retained land if it was located to the immediate north of the access road, rather than due south. This repositioning would not have any adverse impact on the build process, but it would enable the squaring up of the land take and significantly reduce the operational impact upon us.
