

Summary statement from parties regarding matters that they have previously raised during the examination and that have not been resolved to their satisfaction.

The following is my summary of unresolved matters for ExA attention;

1. Monitoring of and mitigation for negative impact on mental health and well-being of residents, visitors and those working in the area. Including the Applicants' unwillingness to adopt approach of the HS2 project. Just because it is difficult to attribute does not mean the Applicant should not be required to include this provision.
2. Monitoring of and mitigation for increased traffic, including harm caused by worker traffic, HGVs, LGVs etc. This must include caps on numbers and limit of which routes can be used prior to any commencement and contingency funds should these be exceeded.
3. Extended working hours which will remove any respite provided by previously DCOs for NSIP projects - destroying the mitigation which was examined/agreed.
4. The needs case for SeaLink when the aims can be delivered in a different location or using a different model (off shore mesh). The needs case has not been proven to the extent that exceptional test has been satisfied or that National Landscapes can be used.
5. Monitoring of and mitigation for loss of tourism economy, with funds identified to compensate for impact during road closures, loss of accommodation capacity, loss of unique characteristics of National Landscape, SPA, SSSI and heritage.
6. Monitoring of and mitigation for the harm caused by HDD to RSPB North Warren, Sandlings SPA etc. Lack of detailed analysis of risks including lighting, impact of compounds, frack out and bentonite.
7. Cumulative impact of inter and intra projects. Total failure of the Applicant to access anything as being significantly impactful.
8. Concern regarding precedent that may be gained by including detail of Lionlink cable runs when this project and its harms have not been examined. (REP4-086).

In light of the above I would request that the ExA requests a pause and that the project is re-evaluated. If the ExA is minded to recommend approval further time will be needed to examine and resolve the above. Thank you.
