

We wish to comment on the proposed list of issues.

With regard to the issue 'Transport and Traffic'

Please add the following sub-issue:

Siting of and/or choice of local routes for construction traffic.

This arises from our representations regarding the routing of traffic in Section D from the A12 along the A134 through our parish, concerns arising from such, and the invitation to consider other options, such as a more direct route constructed and/or designated directly off the A12 at Junction 28 or at Langham or otherwise, to avoid congesting local roads and disturbing residential and village areas, and avoid other harms we have identified.

Great Horkesley Parish Council request that consideration is given to having a site visit, preferably accompanied, in our Parish. This is to assist with the following issues:

- The siting of the Eastern Sealing End Compound at Horkesley Plantation and impact thereof including on national landscape & its surrounds.
- The extremely close proximity of the underground line and construction works to residences and sensitive heritage assets including several listed properties on The Causeway and School Road and assessment of harm.
- The impact of the proposed route for section D construction traffic through the village and impact on safety of road-users, particularly pedestrians.
