The Colchester United Football stadium nearby is next to the A12, has a huge car park and large conference rooms available for hire. Wouldn't that have been a better suited venue?

This seems to follow suit with National Grids other objections to having consultation venues in Ardleigh as well which has a large village Hall again with ample parking and yet a hall was chosen in Lawford which isn't impacted by the route at all and was held on days like the Tendring Show so access was severely impacted due to thousands of visitors.
