

I continue to object to this proposal for the following reasons:

- the location where one pylon will be situated is very close to a NDHA which will affect the outlook. One proposal (of many different ones that I have seen) has the compulsory purchase of one house in this location and another has the base of a pylon at the bottom of someone's garden. Will an independent EMF survey be conducted prior to any further consideration of location of this/ these pylons?
- The vista which will be affected is part of the local village plan which has been submitted. This will protect it as a major characteristic of the village.
- the proposal for the pylon requires considerable preliminary work to reroute another, lower voltage electricity line through our development. The suggestion is to dig up around 500m of private drive in order to do this causing considerable damage to the area and resulting (while the work is being undertaken) a huge amount of upheaval as there are 30 houses sharing one drive which it is suggested needs to be dug up to lay the cable.
- commenting on the exact nature of this proposal has been very difficult due to the conflicting information that all residents in the neighbourhood has received. A meeting held with representatives from Fisher German caused more confusion when they couldn't decipher their own maps. This has caused stress and anxiety for many residents close to the proposed site, made worse by lack of specific communication from the electricity company and those acting on their behalf. We do not need your promotion materials, we need specific answers and an open discussion with people who know what they are talking about in order to comment effectively.
