1 - My property is not a farm, it is a private small holding which is going to be destroyed as the project uses all of the property boundary to boundary. I request NG purchase the property but they refuse leaving us 10's of thousands out of pocket. Life savings in fact. It also severely impacts our day to day lives as 65% of our food comes from this small holding and our live stock.

To the wider impact - So many state we should scrap net zero targets with local councils pulling back from them also, car manufacturers not pushing the electric vehicles as much. With updated information in mind it is widely believed this project is not needed, but a more efficient way is to upgrade existing pylons and lines.

Day to day lives within the 3 counties will be hugely disrupted with construction work vehicles both on and off public roads. Fumes, dust, noise polution and so much more will be so negative.

Property values are already dropping significantly due to this proposed project with some property already un sellable.
