

The Norwich to Tilbury project team have consistently refused to accept that the proposed routing of tall power lines close to the village of Ingatestone, is an important local issue. The Wid valley is an important 'green lung' and recreation area for local residents, and spoiling the view from the valley should be considered carefully. This has not yet been done as the project team have not commented nor have they replied to my many objections. Adjustments to original plans have been made for the Waveney valley and the same should now be done for the Wid. I strongly oppose the despoilation of my local area and believe that the new power lines should be routed underground to preserve the view east from the footpath between Ingatestone Hall and Buttsbury Church. In the eventuality that it is decided to install power lines, then their exact placement matters and the further east they are positioned, the better.
