Tharston and Hapton Parish Council formally request and ASI (Assisted Site Inspection) to show the damage and impact of the proposed erection of the pylons on the Norwich to Tilbury route, with particular regard to the worrying damage to wildlife areas on our footpaths and the general views across the Upper Tas Valley. We also have serious concerns for the worrying health, wellbeing and air quality these pylons would cause along the route of RG024, RG025 and RG026. We are available anytime that week to meet with you and you can park at our community space on Holly lane Hapton NR15 1SE. If the footpaths (BR1, FP33 and FP2) that are on the proposed route were closed for any duration of the construction of the scheme it would have very worrying effect on our local community as these are very well used footpaths with substantial wildlife activity in the area.
